The City of Portland is undertaking a project at 331 Cumberland Avenue, formerly Preble Chapel, which is eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places due to its architectural significance. The project consists of subdividing the first floor nave to construct two child care classrooms and closets, relocation of the lavatory, and demolition of the circa 1924 sanctuary stage. This project will have an adverse effect on the property.

A public meeting to discuss this project is scheduled for 3:00 on August 6, 2013 in room 209, City Hall, 389 Congress Street, Portland Maine 04101.

Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments regarding this project to the City of Portland's Division of Housing and Community Development. All comments received by August 7, 2013 to the above address will be considered by the City of Portland prior to authorizing the project to begin.
