Community Development Block Grant - \$1,975,226; \$375,145 admin and planning; \$892,595 development activities; \$100,000 job creation; and \$607,986 social services.

HOME Consortium with Cumberland County, City of Portland: \$1,582,292; \$209,517 admin; \$150,000 housing rehab; \$0 home ownership; \$130,000 tenant based rental assistance; and \$1,022,448 in new construction, Cumberland County: \$98,577 housing rehab; \$80,000 home ownership; and \$57,745 in new construction.

Emergency solutions grant: \$159,945; \$7,260 admin; \$65,909 homeless assistance; and \$86,474 homeless prevention and rapid rehousing.

The primary objective of City of Portland's Consolidated Housing and Community Development Plan is the development of viable urban communities that include decent housing, a suitable living environment, and expanded economic opportunities, principally for persons of low to moderate income and to aid in the prevention and elimination of slum and blight.

As a recipient of U.S. Housing and Urban Development (HUD) federal funding entitlements, the City of Portland is required to complete an analysis identifying impediments to fair housing choice in the city.
