Health inspections of your establishment were performed on 5/12 & 5/25/99.

Attached is a copy of the inspection reports which indicates that the sanitary condition of your establishment at the time of the inspections were found to be unsatisfactory. The scores were 73 and 59. The minimum marginal passing score is 78.

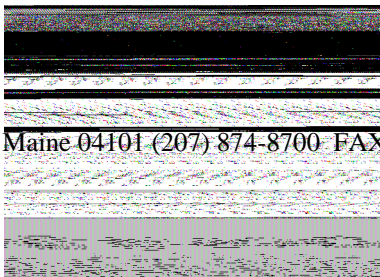
On May 25, 1999 you agreed that you would voluntarily cease operations until corrections can be made and a satisfactory reinspection occurs and all operations comply with the standards set forth in Chapter 11 of the City's Ordinance. On May 26, 1999, an inspection was performed and the score was an 88.

The business was allowed to reopen. A reinspection will occur in June and if the score is below our minimum passing score, our office will refer the matter to the City's Corporation Council to seek suspension of the license pending revocation hearing pursuant to Chapter 15 of the City Code.
