I'm just following up on our telephone conversation.

From what you explained on the telephone, you will be using the space as retail in the front and a print making studio in the rear. The studio will be for intellectually disabled adults working with staff and artists to print shirts, posters etc. Since the previous use was a yoga studio, you need to apply for a change of use permit before you can occupy the space. The sign permit cannot be issued until the change of use permit is approved. With the sign permit, I also need you to provide more information. Please give the dimensions of the sign (12' x 20"?), explain the material that the letters are made out of and describe how they will be attached.
