With the issuance of this permit, the owner, builder or their designee is required to provide adequate notice to the City of Portland Inspections Division for the inspections listed below. Appointments must be requested 48 to 72 hours in advance. The inspection date will need to be confirmed by this office.

- **Please read the conditions of approval that are attached to this permit.**
- **Permits expire in 6 months if the project is not started or ceases for 6 months.**
- **If the inspection requirements below are not followed, then additional fees may be incurred due to the issuance of a "Stop Work Order" and subsequent release to continue.**
- **Per Section 107.3.1 of the Maine Uniform Building and Energy Code (MUBEC), one set of printed approved stamped construction documents will be kept at the site of work and open to inspection by building officials.**

1) All sidewalk signs shall be removed when the business is closed or while any snow or ice exists on the walkway within eight feet of the sign in any direction. All sidewalk signs shall be located near the curb rather than the building face. The sidewalk shall maintain a width of no less than 4 1/2 feet of unobstructed sidewalk width perpendicular to major flows. The sign shall be located within 20' of the entrance to the tenant's space. For a single tenant listing, the maximum width is 24 inches or less if needed for the 4.5 feet of unobstructed sidewalk width. The maximum height of a sidewalk sign is 40 inches to the top of the sign in place. The minimum height of a sidewalk sign is 30 inches to the top of the sign in place.
