Dear Frank and Ben,

This is to let you know that I am approving your application To install new Pella windows at 240 State Street, unit 5.

Approval is based on the following conditions:

- Approval is based on revised specifications forwarded 8-25-17, with all exterior muntins to be 7/8" putty glaze profile.
- Exterior appearance is to mimic original appearance of the historic windows, with painted wood trim, sills, brick mould, etc.
- Screens are to be half screens.
- Glass is to appear clear, non-reflective, and non-tinted, with a minimum visual light transmittance (center of glass only) of .7
- Existing storm window frames are to remain in place (or be reinstalled) to maintain visual consistency, until such time as all storm windows on a façade can be removed at once. Storm panel sash need not be installed in frames if doing so would compromise the new windows.
