Dear SHANOSKI HENRY IVES,

An evaluation of the above-referenced property on **02/27/2018** shows that the structure fails to comply with Chapter 6.Article V. of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Portland, The Housing Code. Attached is a list of the violations.

This is a notice of violation pursuant to Section 6-118 of the Code. All referenced violations shall be corrected within 30 days of the date of this notice. A re-inspection of the premises must occur prior to 04/02/2018 which time compliance will be required. Failure to comply will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1-15 of the Code.

This constitutes an appealable decision pursuant to Section 6-127 of the Code.

Please feel free to contact me if you wish to discuss the matter or have any questions.

Please be advised that the Portland City Council has amended the Building regulations to include a \$150.00 re-inspection fee. This violation will automatically cause a re-inspection at no charge. If there are any subsequent inspections, however, the \$150.00 fee will be assessed for each inspection.

1) 55.051

Violation: NFPA 101-7.2.1.8.1 DOORS SHALL BE SELF-CLOSING & SELF-LATCHING; A door leaf normally

required to be kept closed shall not be secured in the open position at any time and shall be self-closing

or automatic-closing in accordance with 7.2.1.8.2, unless otherwise specified by 7.2.1.8.3.

**Notes:** Unit entry doors need to self close and latch. Self closing hinges or mechanical closer required.

Existing non fire rated doors were previously approved during change of use.

2) 55.161

Violation: NFPA 101- 31.3.4.5.1 SMOKE DETECTOR EACH SLEEPING ROOM; In buildings other than those

equipped through out with an existing, complete automatic smoke detection system, smoke alarms shall be installed in the immediate vicinity of the bedrooms and on all levels of the dwelling unit,

including basements.

Notes: First floor bedroom smoke alarm removed, must be replaced with a hardwired photoelectric smoke

alarm with battery back up. Second floor bedroom smoke alarm is well beyond it's ten year service life and must be replaced with a hardwired photoelectric smoke alarm with battery back up.

3) 55.162

Violation: CITY ORDINANCE HARDWIRED SMOKE DETECTORS REQUIRED; New smoke alarms shall be

powered in accordance with NFPA 72. Where available options include:

Hardwired with battery back up

A non-rechargeable, non-replaceable primary battery that is capable of operating the device for

at leat 10 years

Existing smoke alarms shall be hardwired and replaced every 10 years with smoke alarms complying

with the above notes.

All new smoke alarms shall be photoelectric.

Notes: First and second doors require additional hardwired smoke alarms in vicinity of bedrooms due to door

arrangement in units. Basement requires hardwired smoke alarm. All new smoke alarms must be

photoelectric with battery back up.

4) 8.028

Violation: NFPA 101- 9.7.5. PROVIDE TEST & COMPLIANCE DOCUMENTATION; All automatic sprinkler and

standpipe systems required by this Code shall be inspected, tested, and maintained in accordance with

NFPA 25, Standard for the Inspection, Testing, and Maintenance of Water-Based Fire Protection

Systems.

Notes: Sprinkler system requires annual inspection, last inspected January 2016
