Dear Mr. Schurman

Permit to change the use of the above building with alterations as per plan is being issued herewith, subject to the following Building Code requirements.

Please provide this office with computations showing that the boiler room will receive enough air combustion and that super-heated air, if any, will be exhausted therefrom.

A one-hour fire resistant enclosure and fire door is required around all of the trash and storage rooms on each floor.

A two-hour fire resistant enclosure is required around the elevator shaft.

All of the doors in and out of the two-hour fire resistant stairwells are required to be equipped with latches which will open without the use of keys, special knowledge or ability but by merely turning the usual knob or by pressure on a plate or lever. The same requirement applies to all doors leading to the outside.

Wherever, or if, vent ducts penetrate any fire wall, fire dampers are required to be installed.

Even though Lt. Collins and I went over these plans with you, it might be well to contact him to see if he is completely satisfied with all exiting and safety requirements.

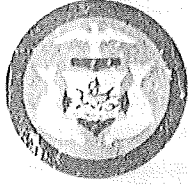

Gentlemen:

Certificate of Occupancy and building permit to change the use of this building at the above named location from a school use to an apartment house with 17 dwelling units are not issuable under the Zoning Ordinance in the R-6, Residential Zone in which this property is located because:

1. The area of the lot on which the buildings are located is only about 9,240 sq. ft. instead of the minimum of 21,000 sq. ft. (1,000 sq. ft. per family.) Sec. 602.7B.3
2. Off street parking spaces for 4 cars are to be provided instead of the minimum of 17 spaces (one for each family housed). Sec. 602.14B.1

Dear Sir:

A recent inspection of the above-mentioned property by a Designating State Fire Inspector revealed the existence of conditions which are in violation of the laws pertaining to fire and structural safety.

Accordingly, the following steps are to be taken to remedy these conditions:

P

1. All stairways, with the exception of the basement stairs, to be enclosed with 1/2 hour fire resistive material with self-closing doors at each level which are not to open over stairs.
2. Dumb-waiter to be lined with one hour fire resistive material with self-closing doors at each level. Alternate - complete enclosure and cut off at each floor level.
3. Cut off corridor from dumb-waiter, third floor, to fire door in adjoining building or provide a Class A fire escape from this area to the ground.
4. Enclose and cut off elevator shaft in the main hall with one hour fire resistive material.
5. Provide emergency lights for all corridors and exits throughout the building in accordance with the Building Exits Code.
6. Door to the attic, third floor, to be covered with 1/2 hour fire resistive material with self closer.
7. Fire escape, third floor to the ground, to have walkway with handrails across roof at the second or level outside. Underside of this roof to be minimum one hour fire resistive material.
8. Second floor to have Class A fire escape to ground level.
9. Linen chute to be handled in the same manner as the dumb-waiter.
10. Window on the fire escape, first floor to ground now with metal frame, to have wired glass inserted in frame.
11. Door to rear passageway leading to adjoining building, second floor, to have self closer.
12. Transom over this door to be enclosed with 1/2 hour fire resistive material.
