Tyler, the owner information is a **requirement**. You must provide the correct information on the application. This application will not be entered until you get that completed and accurate. All applications must show right, title & interest for the proposed work. Right, title & interest can be proven in a number of ways; providing the correct owner information on the application itself, providing documentation showing the changing of ownership (usually by providing a copy of the first page of the purchase and sales agreement, if this is a lease, then a copy of the lease showing they have right, title, and interest to do the work performed, or a letter or note expressing approval from the owner.

Your application will stay on hold until this information has been received.
