An evaluation of the above-referenced property on 06/30/2017 shows that the structure fails to comply with Chapter 6.Article V. of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Portland, The Housing Code. Attached is a list of the violations.

This is a notice of violation pursuant to Section 6-118 of the Code. All referenced violations shall be corrected within 30 days of the date of this notice. A re-inspection of the premises will occur on 08/01/2017 at which time compliance will be required. Failure to comply will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1-15 of the Code.

This constitutes an appealable decision pursuant to Section 6-127 of the Code.

Please be advised that the Portland City Council has amended the Building regulations to include a \$150.00 re-inspection fee. This violation will automatically cause a re-inspection at no charge. If there are any subsequent inspections, however, the \$150.00 fee will be assessed for each inspection.

1) 6-109.5.(c)

Violation: EXTERIOR WINDOWS, DOORS AND SKYLIGHTS.; Every window or door, including basement or

cellar door and hatchway, and skylight shall be substantially weathertight, watertight and vermin-proof,

and shall be kept secured to prevent ingress of people and animals.

Notes: Multiple broken windows in basement and third floor must be repaired and made water and weather

tight.

2) 12.79

Violation: JUNK VEHICLES; It shall be unlawful for any person owning or occupying private property in the City to

keep or allow to accumulate any old, discarded, worn out or junked motor vehicle, or parts thereof, on private property after having received written notice form the City, by the City Mananger or by an official designated by the City Mananger, ordering the removal from the property upon not less that thirty (30) days from receipt of the order of the old, discarded, worn out or junked motor vehicle, or parts thereof.

Notes: Two unregistered vehicles in driveway must be removed or registered within 30 days
