The Property is located within a R-6 Residential Zone. It is not located within a Historic Overlay Zone. I have determined that the current legal use of the Property is five dwelling units and a "neighborhood municipal center". Although the building was originally built as a six family dwelling (October 22, 1916), the most current permit we have on file from 1994 (#9400017) changed the use from apartment to Neighborhood Municipal Center. Since this is the most current permit, the legal use of the property is five dwelling units and a Neighborhood Municipal Center. The present use of the building as a six family dwelling is not legal.

The current owner, Intown Property Holdings, LLC, has applied for a permit (#2015-02624) to legalize the one nonconforming dwelling unit to make the legal use of the building six residential units. This permit is currently being reviewed.
