Dear Zoning Administrator:

I am requesting a permit to allow me the use of my residence at 116 Sherman St. for a home occupation. I intend to serve as an independent leather gauntlet manufacturer, creating customize leather gauntlet braces for clinical organizations. In effect my work will be mold-ing plaster and sewing leather materials which is an acceptable home occupation listed under item (15) of section 14-410 of the Portland Zoning Ordinance. The following is an explanation of how my home occupation meets the criteria listed under item (1) of the same.

- My home occupation will occupy approximately 150 square feet (17%) of floor area of the residence
- No goods will be stored displayed or be visible from outside the residence
- Storage of the material necessary to perform my occupation are minimal and included in the 150 square feet of floor space mentioned above
- There will be no external signage related to my home occupation
- No exterior alterations to the residence are neccesary
- Since I will not be meeting clients at my residence, no additional parking is neccessary
- No objectionable effects will result from my home occupation
- I will not require the services of any employees
- Since I will not be meeting clients at my residence, no additional traffic will be generated by my home occupation
- No vehicles even nearing a gross vehicle weight of 6,000 pounds are necessary for my home occupation

As you can see, my home occupation is a secondary and incidental use of my residence. The external activity level and impact is negligible and in keeping with the residential character of the neighborhood.

Attached you will find a copy of a floor plan showing my entire dwelling and area of home occupation space. I certify that I am the owner of the house and do not need permission to conduct a home occupation. Thank you for your asisstance in this matter.
