Nancy -

Now that we are using E-Plan exclusively, we need a bar scale on each plan so we can calibrate our measuring tool in order to measure distances. Ok, will provide.

Having looked at all the plans more carefully, I still have some questions.

1. Is the dormer for the bathroom the only increase in floor area in the attic? The dormer is the only increase in volume. The other volume of the attic exists, but is presently largely unfinished.

2. Plan A201 shows the section through the dormer, but I don't know how long the dormer is on the outside. It is 9'4" long in the N-S direction.

3. Do you have an elevation plan of the left side of the building, to show the new dormer and the deck above it? No we don't. Just the sections as submitted. The distance to the neighboring house to the west makes it almost impossible to see this side of the house.

4. What is the height of the top of the deck from grade? Will have to have the Owner's confirm, but it is assuredly under the 45 foot height limit.

5. What are the dimensions of the deck and the stair tower enclosure.

Roof top access hut: 6'3" E-W direction x 7'0" N-S direction. Deck: 9'4" N-S, with jog of 2'8"; 12'5" N-S on the East side; 17'6" E-W on the South side.
