Sorry for the delay in contacting you and your team. I did get your voicemail and will return your call.

The hallway work is completed and we can set up a re-inspection when you like. I will be available this Friday morning, 7/28, if that can work for you. The building is technically an 11 unit now, though I still have to remove the stove from Apt. #9, which is currently vacant. That will probably be done by the time you re-inspect.

My wife and I were discussing the question of whether the building can be returned to 12 units at a future date when we have planned financially for the full smoke alarm system as outlined by you and the contractors we met with. Maybe that is a question for another department.
