Conditions:

1) This permit is approved based upon information provided by the design professional. Any deviation from the final approved plans requires separate review and approval prior to work.

The Design Professional is to assess the water damage/ decay to the interior portions of the rear stairwell/ exterior wall as discussed during our walkthrough inspection. New or renovated stairs will require separation review and approval. Modifications may be required on the existing stairs, guards, and handrails.

- 2) Insulation shall comply with the IECC, 2009 (Maine State Energy Codes).
- 3) Demolition permits are valid for a period of 30 days from the date of issuance. A written request must be submitted and granted for an extension to this time period. Dust prevention shall be controlled per Chapter 6 of the Municipal Ordinance and demolition per Section 3303 of the IBC 2009 (MUBEC).

Utility connections. Service utility connections shall be discontinued and capped in accordance with the approved State and City or Portland rules and requirement.

3306.1 Protection required. Pedestrians shall be protected during construction, remodeling and demolition activities as required by this chapter and Table 3306.1. Signs shall be provided to direct pedestrian traffic.

No permit shall be issued until the applicant has removed and disposed of all "friable asbestos" such material in accordance with applicable state and federal regulations.

- 4) All penetrations between dwelling units and dwelling units and common areas shall be protected with approved fire resistant materials "permitted by the building type of construction", and recessed lighting/vent fixtures shall not reduce the (1 hour) required rating per Sec. 712 of the IBC (MUBEC).
- 5) Separate permits are required for any electrical: plumbing, sprinkler, fire alarm, HVAC systems, commercial hood exhaust systems and fuel tanks. Separate plans may need to be submitted for approval as a part of this process.
