Evaluation of the first floor apartment occupied by Mario Kee -Sigueras revealed German Cockroach infestation and an accumulation of materials making ingress and egress difficult. Based on these conditions, it is required that the violations be corrected or the apartment be vacated by 4/23/99. Once it is vacated the materials must be removed. At that time it is required that the necessary action take place to eliminate German Cockroach activity in the building.

This order is pursuant to Section 120.(1) (3) of the ordinance. This is a violation of section 109.5 and 116. of the City of Portland Housing Code. A reinspection will occur on 4/23/99 at which time compliance will be expected. Failure to comply will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1 -15 of the Code and in Title 30-A M.R.S.A. ss 4452.
