Dear Mr. Rice;

An evaluation of your property at the above reference address on January 4, 2000 revealed that refuse has been placed at the curbside for collection. The collection day for your area is Wednesday.

Attached is a copy of the Garbage and Solid Waste Removal Code of the City of Portland. Pursuant to Section 12-21.(a) refuse containers cannot be place at the curb for collection prior to 3 p.m. the day before collection. As the owner of the property, you have failed to comply with this Stion.

Please be advised that after 3 violation within a twelve month period, Section 128 of the Ordinance requires that a \$100.00 fee or charge be assessed for the collection of up to one cubic yard of waste that remains on the curb, sidewalk, esplanade or street after the expiration of the time period for compliance with an order to remove said waste. Failure to pay the assessed fee within 30 days shall cause the City to assess a lien against the property pursuant to Section 116 of the Code.

Future violations can result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1-230 of the Code. In addition to the fees previously stated, the fines escalate as follows:

1st Violation: \$50.00, 2nd Violation: \$100.00 3rd Violation: \$150.00 plus attorneys fees and costs
