- 3) Notice: The first scheduled final inspection fee is at no charge. Additional inspections shall be billed at \$75 for each inspector.
- 4) The entire sprinkler system shall be maintained in accordance with NFPA 25, Standard for Inspection, Testing and Maintenance of Water-Based Fire Protection Systems, 2008 edition.
- 5) System acceptance and commissioning must be coordinated with a fire alarm technician and suppression system contractors and the Fire Department. Call 874-8400 to schedule.
- 6) Fire department connection shall be two 2 ½" inlets unless the riser is 3" or less.(NFPA 1963, Standard For fire Hose Connections.)
- 7) Pay special attention in the following NFPA 13 Chapters:
