

Building & Fire Code Requirements

2. All concrete shall conform to Chapter 19 of the city's building code sections 1901.1, 1903.1.1, 1905.1, table 1907.1.2[1], 1908.9 and 1908.10.
3. All masonry shall conform to Chapter 21 of the city's building code section 2101.1.1, 2104.3, 2105.7, 2112.3, and 2112.4.
4. All glass and glazing shall conform to the city's building code Chapter 24 sections 2404.0 and 2405.0 2406.0 and 2407.0.
