- 1) Installation shall be in accordance with the City of Portland Fire Department Regulations and NFPA 13 as published. A copy of the State Sprinkler permit with RMS date and signature and the Contractor's Material and Test Certificate for Aboveground Piping (NFPA 13 figure 24.1) shall be provided prior to scheduling of the final inspection.
- 2) Prior to final inspection the Fire Department shall be provided with the State Sprinkler Permit with RMS sign off and date, and the completed and signed Contractor's Material and Test Certificates.
- 3) System acceptance and commissioning must be coordinated with alarm and suppression system contractors and the Fire Department. Call 874-8400 to schedule.
- 4) The entire sprinkler system shall be maintained in accordance with NFPA 25, Standard for Inspection, Testing and Maintenance of Water-Based Fire Protection Systems, 2008 edition.
- 5) A sprinkler supervisory system shall be provided in accordance with NFPA 101, Life Safety Code, and NFPA 72, National Fire Alarm and Signaling Code. Sprinkler supervisory systems shall monitor for water flow and sprinkler supervisory signals via an approved fire alarm panel to central station. One smoke detector shall be located over the panel, a manual pull station located at the front door, and an audible water flow alarm provided. A separate fire alarm permit is required from a certified fire alarm company.
- 6) NFPA 1 Fire Code Per 1.14.4 Review and approval by the AHJ shall not relieve the applicant of the responsibility of compliance with this Code.
