


# Congress Street Closure

- What:
  - On Congress St between Forest St and Weymouth St immediately adjacent to MMC's Visitor Garage
- When:
  - May and June 2018
- How Long:
  - 8 weeks (includes several contingency days)

# Intent

- Minimize the impact of the Congress St closure
- Provide a safe and reliable system for commuters and local traffic
- Reduce the volume of traffic that approaches the closure location to avoid concentrating traffic at the closure
- Ongoing monitoring of traffic to identify opportunities to improve real-time





# Congress St Detour Best Option

- Dilute traffic adjacent to Congress St closure with variable message signage
- Inbound:
  - Congress St > St John St > Park Ave > Weymouth St > Congress St
  - Local Traffic Only:
    - » Congress St > Forest St > Boynton St > Weymouth St > Congress St
    - » No parking on Boynton St temporarily to allow for emergency vehicle access
- Outbound:
  - Congress St > Weymouth St > Park Ave
  - Temporary signal on Weymouth St / Park Ave
- Flaggers and Police where appropriate



#### Sea Dogs Game Days

- Police controlled pedestrian crossing
- Added signalized pedestrian crossing
- Add message to variable message boards
- Additional flaggers as needed

### Sea Dogs Mother's Day 5k Detour Impact




- Close Park Ave between St John and Deering

  - Detour traffic to Commercial St until race end (approx. 11:00 AM)





# Detour Signage Detail (cont.)

#### **General Notes and Sign Specifications**

#### GENERAL NOTES:

- ALL TRAFFIC CONTROL SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES FOR STREET AND HIGHWAYS (MUTCD), USDOT, FHWA, LATEST EDITION, AND CITY STANDARDS.
- SIGN LOCATIONS SHOWN ARE APPROXIMATE. ACTUAL LOCATIONS SHALL BE DETERMINED IN THE FIELD AND APPROVED BY THE CITY.
- 3. OTHER SIGNS MAY BE NEEDED AS DIRECTED BY THE
- CITY. ALL CONTROL DEVICES SHALL BE PLACED IN HIGHLY VISIBLE LOCATIONS.
- ALL CONSTRUCTION RELATED TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNS NOT IN EFFECT SHALL BE COVERED OR TURNED FROM TRAFFIC VIEW UNTIL THEY ARE MADE ACTIVE. SIGNS SHALL BE COVERED OR REMOVED WHEN THE WORK IS NOT ACTIVE.
- ANY EXISTING SIGNS OR PAVEMENT MARKINGS DAMAGED DURING CONTRUCTION SHALL BE RESTORED TO THEIR ORIGINAL CONDITIONS OR REPLACED AS NEEDED.
- ANY CONFLICTING SIGNS OR PAVEMENT MARKINGS SHALL BE COVERED OR REMOVED AS NEEDED.
- 8. CHANNELIZING DEVICES SHALL BE PLACED PER MUTCD.
- 9. POST-MOUNTED SIGNS SHALL BE A MINIMUM HEIGHT OF 7 FEET (TO THE BOTTOM OF THE SIGN) AND MUST BE CRASHWORTHY.

TEMPORARY SIGNALIZATION: SIGNAL SHALL BE ON FLASH FOR A MINIMUM OF ONE WEEK PRIOR TO BEING PUT INTO RED-YELLOW-GREEN OPERATION. THE SIGNAL SHALL BE PUT INTO RED-YELLOW-GREEN OPERATION PRIOR TO 6 AM ON A MONDAY MORNING AND SIGNAL CONTRACTOR SHALL REMAIN ON-SITE UNTIL A MINIMUM OF 9 AM TO MAKE ADJUSTMENTS TO SIGNALS / TIMING PER THE DIRECTION OF THE CITY TRAFFIC ENGINEER OR REPRESENTATIVE. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ALSO BE AVAILABLE FROM 11 AM TO 1 PM AND AGAIN FROM 3 PM TO 6 PM ON THE SAME DAY TO MAKE ADJUSTMENTS AS DIRECTED BY THE CITY ENGINEER OR THEIR REPRESENTATIVE. TWO WEEKS AFTER INITIAL RED-YELLOW-GREEN INITIALIZATION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE AVAILABLE AT THOSE SAME TIMES FOR FURTHER ADJUSTMENTS AS DIRECTED BY THE CITY TRAFFIC ENGINEER OR THEIR REPRESENTATIVE.

NOTE: SIZES OF SIGNS AND LETTERING ON ALL SIGNS SHALL BE VERIFIED THAT THEY MEET MUTCD REQUIREMENTS PRIOR TO ORDERING AND INSTALLATION.
