The building elevations from Perkins & Will contain the correct building height. The difference is the result of a miscommunication during the application process between the architects and HeliExperts (our sound engineers). HeliExperts reached out to the FAA to make them aware of the discrepancy and were instructed to correct the information when the heliport activation form is filed nearer to the completion of the project. Apologies for the confusion.

The height of the heliport will be 271'10" above sea level.
