For our items under comment number 6:

- i. **Documentation of design approval from the manufacturer of the stormwater treatment system:** I searched through the files uploaded to e-plan after the last submission and could not find a letter. Please let me know if it would be appropriate for me to call or e-mail Mr. Senus directly, as it may be a quick conversation to confirm the file location.
- ii. **Revised plans addressing slope inconsistencies:** The applicant has addressed this item, no further comment.
- iii. **Regarding the oil/water separator at the elevator:** The applicant's plan of coordinating final acceptability with DPW is appropriate. We agree that hydraulic elevators are more of a concern, but there is still grease and other contaminants in the elevator shafts and a potential for pollution.
