I now have comments back from both Corporation Counsel and DPW on this. See attached.


Also, as you may recall, it is the city's policy to charge for overhangs in the ROW. (This will need to be addressed in the encroachment license, eventually.) I have done some preliminary calculations of total floor area (including all floors) in the overhang area based on the dimensions in the diagram that you provided here. Perkins + Will provided more precise numbers during the site plan review, but it would be helpful to circle back to them to verify. (The figure they provided during site plan is attached.) The practice is to charge for total SF in the overhang (again, all floors) based on an assessed value/SF figure for the subject property. If you can get me a final plan and figures from Perkins + Will, I can do the math and give you a final number.




