Dear Sir:

Permit for the above work is issued herewith, subject to the following:

1. No part of new partitions will be built closer than three feet from sides or back of existing heater unless a shield of metal or other incombustible material is provided on the part of the partition closer than that, in which case a minimum separation of two feet is allowable.
2. All woodwork is required to be kept at least one inch away from the warm air pipe, which presumably is part of the warm air heating system for the building. However, if this pipe is the smokepipe from the heater, it is required to be kept at least 15" below any combustible ceiling or 12" away from any combustible material at side of pipe. Where it passes through any partition, a safety thimble at least 12" in diameter or twice the diameter of the pipe, if that is more than 6", is required for the full thickness of the partition, the smokepipe to be centered where it passes through this thimble.
3. We are assuming that basement has previously been used for church purposes and that there are two separate means of egress from this basement.
4. Before any sheetrock or sheathing is applied to partitions or ceiling, notice should be given this office for inspection, at which time a green tag will be issued if everything is found in order.
5. Unless you are willing to abide by these conditions or if there is any doubt as to just what is required, you should not start any work but should get in touch with this office before going ahead.

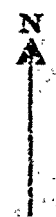


