The last permit we have on file is an amendment from June 26, 2015 to permit #51/1101 which gave the use as 6 apartments and five lodging rooms - 4 apartments on the first floor, two apartments and two lodging rooms on the second floor and three lodging rooms on the third floor.

There is evidence to legalize three units to make it a legal nonconforming nine unit building - the 1982 assessor's card has it as a 9 unit and two "Notice of Housing Conditions" from the Inspections Office one from 1978 & one from 1991 stating that there were 9 units.
