- 9. Private garages located hereal habitable rooms in occupancies in Use Grace Not. Ro2, Ro3 or I-1 shall be separated from adjacent interior spaces by Fire Partitions and floor/ceiling assembly ; lies which are constructed with not less than 1-hour rime resisting rating. Private garages attached side-by-size to rooms in the above occupancies shall be completely separated from the interior spaces and the attic area by means of 1/2 inch gaptum board or the equivalent applied to the garage side. (Chapter 4 section 407.0 of the BOCA/1993).
- 10. Guardrails & Handrails A quardrail system is a system of hullding components located near the open sides of elevated walking surfaces for the surpress of minimizing the possibility of an accidental fail from the walking surface to the lower level. Minimum height all Use Group 42°, except Use Group R which is 36°. In occupancies in Use Group A, B, H-4, II, I=2 M and R and public gatages and open parking structures, open guards shall have balusters or be of solid material much that a sphere with a dissecer of 4° cannot pass through any opening. Guards shall not have an occasental pattern that would provide a ladder effect.
 - 11. All exit signs, lights and means of egress lighting shall be done in accordance with Compter 10, section & subsections 1023.5 1024.0 of the City's building code (The BOCA National Building Code/1993).
 - 12. Stair construction in Use Group R-3, R-4 is a sinises of 9" trend and 8-1/4" maximum rise.
 - 13. Headroom in habitable space is a minimum of 7'6".
 - 14. The minimum headroom in all parts of a stairmay shall not be less than 80 inches.
- 15. All construction and demolition debris must be disposed at the City's authorized reclamation site. The fee rate is attached. Proof of such disposed must be furnished to the office of Inspection Services before final certificate or occupancy is issued or demolition pepult is granted.
- 16. Section 25-135 of the Minicipal Code for the City of Portland states: "No person or utility shall be granted a permit to excavate or open any street or sidewalk from the time of November 15 of each year to April 15 of the following year".
- 17. The builder of a facility to which Section 4594-C of the Maine State Muman Rights Act, Title 5 MSEA refers, shall obtain a certification from a design professional that the plans of the facility meet the standards of construction required by this section. Prior to communing construction of the facility, the builder shall submit the certification to the Division of Inspection Services.
