An evaluation of the above reference property on 6/14/2012, shows that the structure fails to comply with Chapter 6 Article V of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Portland, The Housing Code. Attached is a list of the violations.

This is a notice of violation pursuant to Section 6-118 of the Code. All referenced violations shall be corrected within 7 days of the date of this notice. A re-inspection of the premises will occur on 6/21/2012 at which time compliance will be required. Failure to comply will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporate Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1-15 of the Code.

This constitutes an appealable decision pursuant to Section 6-127 of the Code.

Please be advised that the Portland City Council has amended the Building regulations to include a \$75.00 re-inspection fee. This violation will automatically cause a re-inspection at no charge. If there are any subsequent inspections, however, the \$75.00 fee will be assessed for each.

1. MAINTENANCE OF SHARED ARE-City Ord. § 6-109.(b)
