



One or Two Family Fire Sprinkler Permit Application Checklist

All of the following information is required and must be submitted. Checking off each item as you prepare your application package will ensure your package is complete and will help to expedite the permitting process.

Complete and submit the following:

- Vectored pdf plans and documents included (same as submitted to the State Fire Marshal)*
- Sprinkler installation costs (do not include domestic installation costs): \$5000.00
- State Sprinkler license number: 903
- State Sprinkler Permit / log number: 11145
- Occupancy Classification: Single-Family Home Two-Family Home
- Total square feet of protected floor space: 1800 sq ft
- Number of stories: 2
- Is this a multipurpose piping system? Y / N
- Does the system use pex piping? Y / N
- Water supply: Municipal Pump and tank Other: _____
- A city plumbing permit has been pulled
- A copy of the state sprinkler permit with RMS sign off is required prior to the final inspection

Separate permits are required for internal and external plumbing, & electrical installations.

Please submit all of the information outlined in this application checklist. If the application is incomplete, the application may be refused.

In order to be sure the City fully understands the full scope of the project, the Planning and Development Department may request additional information prior to the issuance of a permit.
