I am taking a look at the building permit to rebuild the front & side porches/steps at 59 Pine Street. I had a question in particular about the rebuild of the side steps, which will entail a slight expansion in order to create a platform for the first step. Can you just confirm that the existing porch and proposed expansion will be completely located within the property boundary? I don't have a survey, so using only the tax map it looks very close to the side property line. I can't approve an expansion if it will encroach on the neighboring property. Thanks for any clarification you can provide.
