OUTDOOR RECREATIONAL FIRES

Authorized types of outdoor recreational fires (check one):

- Outdoor Fireplaces, portable fire bowls and Chimineas.

These shall be **at least 15 feet** from a structure, combustible material and property lines.

- Recreational fires not in a fireplace.

This is defined as burning clean, dry, cord type firewood as in a standard campfire setting. The fire must be in a pit and fire ring, less than 3 feet in diameter with pile less than 2 feet in height. These recreational fires shall be no closer than **25 feet** from a structure, combustible material and property lines.

A permit is required for this type of fire. Apply for a permit at www.portlandfire.com

Check all that apply:

- Where burning is conducted on public property or the property of someone other than the applicant, the person responsible for outdoor burning shall demonstrate that permission has been obtained by the appropriate government agency, property owner, or the property owners authorized agent.
- A responsible adult, over the age of 18, shall be in attendance at all times during the event.
- Smoke from any outdoor burning must not create a public nuisance by impacting neighboring properties.
- Burning of trash, construction materials leaves, brush, deadwood and tree cuttings accrued from normal property maintenance is prohibited.
- A method of extinguishment shall be available at time of outdoor burning, such as a fire extinguisher or garden hose. Entering your initials to the left indicates you acknowledge, understand and agree to abide by this rule.
- No outdoor burning is allowed if winds are greater than 15mph or the State Forest Division has classified the fire danger as more than a class 1 or 2 day on the day of the proposed burn. You may obtain the fire class day by clicking the link "Fire Danger Report" at www.portlandfire.com
- A permit shall be required for all outdoor recreational fires that are not in an outdoor fireplace, portable fire bowl or chimineas.
