An evaluation of your property at 98 Clark Street on December 2, 1999 revealed that the premises fails to comply with Section 12.79 of the Garbage, Waste and Junk Ordinance of the City of Portland.

Left drive 1 uninspected and unregistered Buick Skyhawk, Color Beige. 2 stickers on the rear bumper, drivers side AAA Plus sticker, Passenger side sticker that says (100.3) Car must be registered and stickered to be legal beyond 30 days.

This is a notice of violation pursuant to Section 12.79 of the Code. All referenced violations shall be corrected within 30 days of the date of this notice. A re-inspection of the premises will occur on December 30, 1999 at which time compliance will be required. Failure to comply will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1-15 of the code and in title 30-A M.R.S.A. Ss 4452.
