## CITY OF PORTLAND NOTICE OF VIOLATION

## Dear NCCS:

An evaluation of your property at 11 May St. on March 21, 2001 revealed that the vacant lot fails to comply with Section 14-463 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Portland, the Land Use Code.

Parking Lot: Red Toyota Station Wagon VT Plate - BTE 337
White Ford Contour ME Plate 4402 GY
Blue Cheverolet S-10 Pickup Texas Plate 1 XW C97

Per Section 14-463(4) a certificate of occupancy shall be required for occupancy and use, or change of use, of vacant land, except for the raising of crops.

This is a notice of violation pursuant to Section 14-57 of the Municipal Code. All referenced violations shall be corrected within 30 days of the date of this notice. A re-inspection of the premises will occur on March 28, 2001 at which time compliance will be required. Failure to comply will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Chapter 1-15 of the Code and in Title 30-A M.R.S.A. ss4452.
