Dear Mr. Grassi,

During an inspection of your building at 105 Clark Street, at the request of Inspector Dwight Gailey, the following unsafe or hazardous conditions were found:

- 1. Room 1-3 Smoke detector is not properly located in accordance with N.F.P.A. #74.
- 2. Room 1-2 Smoke detector not working wires not connected and location is improper as in #1.
- 3. Room 1-1 Smoke detector See #1

Front Stairway

- 4. Battery operated smoke detector not working no battery.
- Light fixture damaged, no bulbs inadequate illumination as a result.
- 6. Interior two balusters missing.
- 7. Chimney clean out door missing
- 8. Chimney is deteriorated and in need of masonry repair.
- 9. An uncovered electrical junction box.

Second Floor

- 10. Room 2-2 Loose ceiling light fixture.
- 11. Rear exit door latch is an improper locking device.

Exterior

- 12. Rear porch is dilapidated and rails and guards do not meet the requirements of Section 5-2 of the N.F.P.A. 101 Life Safety Code.
- 13. Right side entrance porch rails do not meet the requirements of Section 5-2 and the entrance exit door does not operate properly due to dragging on floor.
- 14. Front stair rails do not meet the requirements of Section 5-2.

Fire Alarm System

- 15. Manual pullstations are not provided at each exit from the second floor.
- 16. The fire alarm control does not have a control panel and does not have the ability to test or zone disconnect, Ref Section 7-6.2
- 17. The requirement for single station smoke detectors outside of the sleeping rooms and on each level does not appear to be met, Ref Section 20-3.4.
- 18. The sleeping room doors are not self-closing smoke tight doors as required in Section 20-5.2.2.
- 19. The present location of the 1st floor cooking stove is in violation of Section 20-5.2.2.

The above listed unsafe or hazardous conditions must be corrected without delay. Your plan of correction must be submitted within 7 days from receipt of this letter.
