This is the project I was just asking you about. The essential problem is that they are seeking an expansion of nonconforming footprint to increase the safety of the stairs/entry landing. The landing itself would be increased from from 8' in length to 10'. We can only approve this if the expansion is the "least amount required to meet life safety code requirements."
