I am in receipt of your application to change the use of the above property from car wash and detailing to a used car dealership with a repair shop. Your permit is denied because it can not meet the requirement of the B-5b Zone in which it is located.

Section 14-230.1 of the Land Use Zoning Ordinance does not list automobile sales and repair services as a permitted use. Section 14-230.3 of the Land Use Zoning Ordinance does not list automobile sales and repair services as a conditional use. Section 14-230.3 of the Land Use Zoning Ordinance states that uses that are not enumerated in either section 14-230.1 or 14-230.2 are prohibited uses.

Your permit is denied.

You have the right to appeal my decision concerning use. If you wish to exercise your right to appeal, you have 30 days from the date of this letter in which to appeal.
