**RE: Notice of Decommissioning of Gas Regulator Station and related Data Building on December 16, 2016
at Maine DOT's 232 West Commercial Street Site**

Dear Doug:

By this letter, Unitil provides notice to the City's Code Enforcement Inspections Division that, on Friday, December 16, 2016, it will be decommissioning its natural gas regulator station and related data building on the Maine Department of Transportation's 232 Commercial Street Site, where depicted on the enclosed Unitil/MDOT Site Plan.

All gas infrastructure within the two buildings will be disconnected and then abandoned in place. All exterior underground gas piping will be isolated, purged, and sealed. The decommissioned structures will then be ready for your inspection as of Monday, December 18th. After your inspection, the Maine DOT will assume full responsibility over the site and will schedule the demolition of the Structures and above-ground piping through its contractor, Shaw Brothers.

We will be happy to provide any further information you may require for the inspection. Thank you for your timely assistance.
