- (o) 1. The proposed ramp and floats have been reviewed and approved by the Portland Planning Authority, the Portland Harbor Commission, the Maine Department of Environmental Protection and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, thus evidencing compliance with local, State and federal regulations.
 - 2. The proposed ramp and float systems have been designed in a manner that adheres to the design and construction standards contained in the US ACOE Shore Protection Manual. The activities have been permitted under USACOE Permit # NAE-2012-02469 and modification approval dated December 2017, on file with the City's Planning Department.

Based on this accompanying information we trust that you can complete the processing of the proposed Travel lift, ramp and float system building permits as well as the Flood Hazard Development Permit application.
