 X Sketches or elevation drawings at a minimum 1/4" scale. Please label relevant dimensions. All plans shall be submitted in 11" x 17" format except for major projects, where 22" x 34" plans are requested. Applicants for major projects should submit one (1) 11" x 17" copy for scanning purposes.
 __ Details or sections, where applicable.
 __ Floor plans, where applicable.
 __ Site plan showing relative location of adjoining structures.
 __ X_ Catalog cuts or product information (e.g. proposed windows, doors, lighting fixtures)
 __ X_ Materials - list all visible exterior materials. Samples are helpful.
