Hello Jeanie,

Thanks very much for the memo summarizing Keith's comments - will forward to SFMO.

We have also heard back from Williams Scotsman on the foundation (the project manager is back this week) - please see below:

Given that the modulares are temporarily installed, they do not provide full foundations or frost protection. The single wide unit will be placed on the same concrete block/abs setup as the double wides as follows:

"Our foundational block is ground level, 3 cell concrete blocks(no mortar) placed on top of ABS pads. There are no sub frost(or any subgrade) footings. Also ramps do not have frost protection or footings either. They sit on aluminum feet on ground level."
