## 15. SOLID WASTE

### 15.1 COMMERCIAL SOLID WASTE

All solid waste materials from the Waynflete School will continue to be transported and disposed of in accordance with applicable laws and regulations. As previously noted, the proposed expansion is not intended to accommodate a larger enrollment; as such, an increase in waste generation from the Site is not anticipated at this time.

### 15.2 CONSTRUCTION & LAND CLEARING DEBRIS

As with any construction project, the proposed construction will generate construction, demolition, and land-clearing debris. The contractor(s) for the construction work will be fully responsible for handling all waste generated by the project and for managing and disposing of it in accordance with Maine Solid Waste Management Regulations - 06-096 CMR 400-409. The contractor(s) will be bound by contract to dispose of all materials in full accordance with applicable Maine regulations and approval of the City of Portland. All efforts will be made during construction to minimize waste and to recycle. Construction debris will be transported to a waste management facility licensed to accept the waste materials.

### 15.3 SPECIAL & HAZARDOUS WASTE

The proposed development will not produce any special or hazardous waste.

### 15.4 FINDINGS

Adequate provisions for solid waste disposal have been made. General solid waste, construction, demolition, and land-clearing debris will be managed in full accordance with all applicable laws and will not cause a deleterious effect on the environment.
