Dear Dr. Cope,

I have enclosed some copies from our microfiche files. They clearly show that our office has considered your building a residential use. We have never considered it a business use. An approved home occupation, such as you were granted in 1970, is an accessory use to a residential use as stated in the City's Zoning Ordinance. Business uses are not allowed in residential zones. Perhaps you can ask the Assessor's Department if this makes a difference in their consideration of how they tax your property. I am not aware of their criteria for assessing buildings. However, I am sure they would be glad to sit down with you and explain more fully some of the changes that you have recently experienced.
