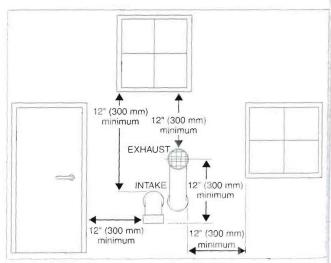


Fig. 16 Vent and air pipe position (1) of a sealed combustion system
