Hi Greg. Thanks for the follow up email. Sorry for the confusion on how the opening was filled. We did not use paneling to fill/cover that – I must have mislead you somehow.

I did frame that space out with 2' x 4's (there was some existing framing around the opening that whoever created the opening must have installed to stabilize the opening area). I did that so I could secure $\frac{3}{4}$ " plywood on the "exterior" side of the framing (which plywood is facing inside the dormer – and not exposed to the outside elements). I think you took a picture of this side of the opening with the plywood from our bathroom window. I installed sheetrock to the inside side of the opening against the frame. That sheetrock is covered in wall paper on the top part, and by wainscoting on the bottom half. The wainscoting was installed a couple of years after we removed the stair and filled the opening.

The framing was, if I remember, every 8" or so across the opening for stability. I may have inserted insulation in there as well, but I don't know that for sure. Since it is not exposed to the exterior, I am not sure I made that a priority.

Hopefully some day we will remove the dormer. At that point a number of things will need to happen – the porch roof will have to be extended to cover the area now occupied by the dormer, and the wall where the opening is will need to be bricked up to match the surrounding area. A permit will obviously be needed for this work, as well as permission from Historic Preservation etc.... I'll need to win the lottery first.
