Good Afternoon.

I have 2 sets of information for this same address. I am being told that the space that is 244 St. John Street has been recently broken up and Catholic Charities who operates the Threads Of Hope Thrift Store has given up a small portion of their space to Camp Ketcha who operates Portland Gear Hub Store in the smaller space but they both use the address of 244 St. John Street. Not knowing how to handle this, I am going to call the Catholic Charities Threads of Hope Thrift Store address 244 and the Camp Ketcha Portland Gear Hub store 244-A.

This email is for the sign permit for 244 and I will send another for 244-A. I hope this is OK and if not please email me back and let me know what I need to do to change it.

They are both doing new signage and here's how it is working. Threads of Hope currently has a 3' X 24' sign and we are chopping it down to 3' X 20' to make room for the Portland Gear Hub sign which will be a new sign that is 3' X 7'. You can see by the photos and drawings what is being done.

Thanks and I hope this is not too difficult to understand. I just assumed from the beginning that since it is 2 different companies....that I needed to apply for 2 separate sign permits.
