Dear Mr Fagone,

I have enclosed the most recent reports from Anthony Ciriello of Buggy's Pest Control Company.

I am waiting for a copy of the most recent treatment done on May 14, 2015, as well as an incident report and complaint from Mr. Ciriello against Danny Cook of Room C, at 26 A Street, regarding interfering with the pest control measures.

As you can see by both the enclosed reports, and the previous reports given you, that we have an ongoing problem with Mr. Cook interfering with our pest control measures. He has been either continually removing or destroying the monitors or bait traps placed into his room. I believe this is a citable incident against Mr. Cook for interfering with our pest control measures.

He also appears to be deliberately trying to breed roaches in his room (see attached). The first time we found a paper-towel problem, we thought it might have been an accident. However, the last two times Buggy's has been here, it has become clear that Mr Cook in Room C is deliberately filling paper-towel rolls with food and/or feces, and stuffing them behind his refrigerator and dresser, causing nests of roaches. Again I believe this is a citable offense against Mr. Cook.

I am hereby making a Formal Complaint on behalf of 26 A Street Lodging, LLC. against Mr. Danny Cook of 26 A Street Rm C, Portland, ME. 04102, for interference with pest control measures, and ask that he be issued a citation, or citations, for these offenses.

I will provide you with Mr Ciriello's reports for the May 15, 2015 treatment, findings, and incident, as soon as I receive them.
