Dear Mr. Meserve & Ms. Dagnese:

An recent inspection of your property at 398400 St. John Street on July 22, 1999 and September 7, 1999 revealed that the rear yard fails to comply with Chapter 12, Article V. Junked Motor Vehicles and Chapter 22 Rodent & Vemin control of the Code of Ordinances of the City

The following is a list of items in rear yard:

Discarded miscellaneous, metals, steel pipes, old condensers, evaporators, junk lawn mowers, winnows, bicycles, oxyacetylene equipment, tanks and miscellaneous rubble.
Discarded U Haul truck body approx 8' x 10', large pile of tires, 1 blue stock car cutlass, 1 rear portion of a car and 1 orange stock car #42.

This is a notice of violation pursuant to Section 229 and 12.79 of the Code. All referenced violations shall be corrected within 30 days of the date of this notice. A reinspection of the premises will occur on 10/7/99 at which time compliance will be required. Failure to comply will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 115 of the Code and in Title 30A M.R.S.A. ss 4452.

This constitutes an appealable decision pursuant to Section 221 and 12-80 of the Code. If you have any questions please feel free to contact me at 8748709.
