HAND DELIVER

An evaluation of your property at 398-400 St. John St. on October 13, 1999 revealed that the rear yard is in violation of Chapter 12, Article V, Junked Motor vehicles and Chapter 22, Rodent and Vermin Control of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Portland.

The following is a list of items in rear yard: Discarded miscellaneous metals, steel pipes, old condensers, junk lawn mowers, windows, bicycles, oxy-acetylene equipment, tanks and miscellaneous rubble.
Discarded U-Haul truck body approx. 8'x10', large pile of tires, 1 blue stock car cutlass, 1 rear portion of a car and 1 orange stock car # 42.

These violations are the same as documented on previous violation notices dated September 7, 1999.

This is a notice of intent to prosecute. The matter is being referred to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section 1-15 of the Code, and in Title 30-A M.R.S.A. Ss 4452.
