- **Permits expire in 6 months. If the project is not started or ceases for 6 months.**

- **Per Section 107.3.1 of the Maine Uniform Building and Energy Code (MUBEC). One set of printed approved stamped construction documents shall be kept at the site of work and shall be open to inspection by building officials.**

Conditions:		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) The installation shall comply with the following: NFPA 72, National Fire Alarm and Signaling Code (2010 edition), as amended by Fire Department Rules and Regulations; and NFPA 70, National Electrical Code (2011 edition) as amended by the State of Maine 2) A copy of the required state sprinkler permit with RMS signoff shall be provided prior to the final inspection. 3) Single-station Carbon Monoxide (CO) alarms are required. They shall be powered by the building's electrical service with battery backup and shall be interconnected. CO alarms shall be installed in the following locations: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Outside each separate dwelling unit sleeping area in the immediate vicinity of the bedrooms (2) On every occupiable level of the dwelling unit, including basements, excluding attics and crawl spaces 4) All fire alarm records required by NFPA 72 should be stored in an approved cabinet located at the FACP labeled "FIRE ALARM RECORDS". 5) All smoke detectors shall be photoelectric. 6) The fire alarm technician shall be present for the fire inspection. System acceptance and commissioning must be coordinated with alarm and suppression system contractors and the Fire Department. Call 874-8400 to schedule. 7) The fire alarm system shall have a new fire alarm inspection sticker. 8) Fire alarm system requires a wireless master box connection per city ordinance. Master box design and installation shall in conformance with Fire Department Regulations and approved by Fire Department Electrical Division. 9) Shall comply with NFPA 101, Chapter 30, New Apartment Buildings
