Dear Miss Portland Imer,

An evaluation of your property a \$\textit{75}\$ Roberts St on Mar-20-2000 time} revealed that the structure remains non-compliant with the Housing Code of the City of Portland.

Attached is a list of the violations.

This is a SECOND notice of violation pursuant to Section 6118 of the Code. All referenced violations shall be corrected within days of the date of this notice. A-**in**spection of the premises will occur on May-01-2000 at which time compliance will be required.

Failure to comply will result in this office referring the matter to the City of Portland Corporation Counsel for legal action and possible civil penalties, as provided for in Section-15 of the Code and in Title 30A M.R.S.A. ss 4452.

Please be advised that because this is the second inspection and there are repeat violations, Section 6.2 of the Code requires that you pay a \$75.00 re-inspection fee. This must be paid prior to May-01-2000. Failure to pay the assessed fee within 30 days shall cause the City to assess a lien against the property pursuant to Section-II 6 of the Code.
